 Very important in any country is to continuously improve Research, Innovation and Education, thereby enabling national experts to identify the energy challenges in a broader context and to come up with robust solutions adapted to local conditions.

These three Topics are proposed for plenary discussion with outstanding invited speakers with academic and industrial background from national and international organisations concerned. Political, social, economic as well as scientific and/or technological messages of common interest will be delivered. Successful achievements and future challenges will be identified.

The expected outcome of the RAOS-2017 international conference is to raise public and private awareness of the opportunities and challenges of sustainable energy development in Africa by bringing together a number of high-level experts who share similar concerns but have few opportunities to discuss solutions of common interest.
