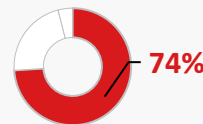

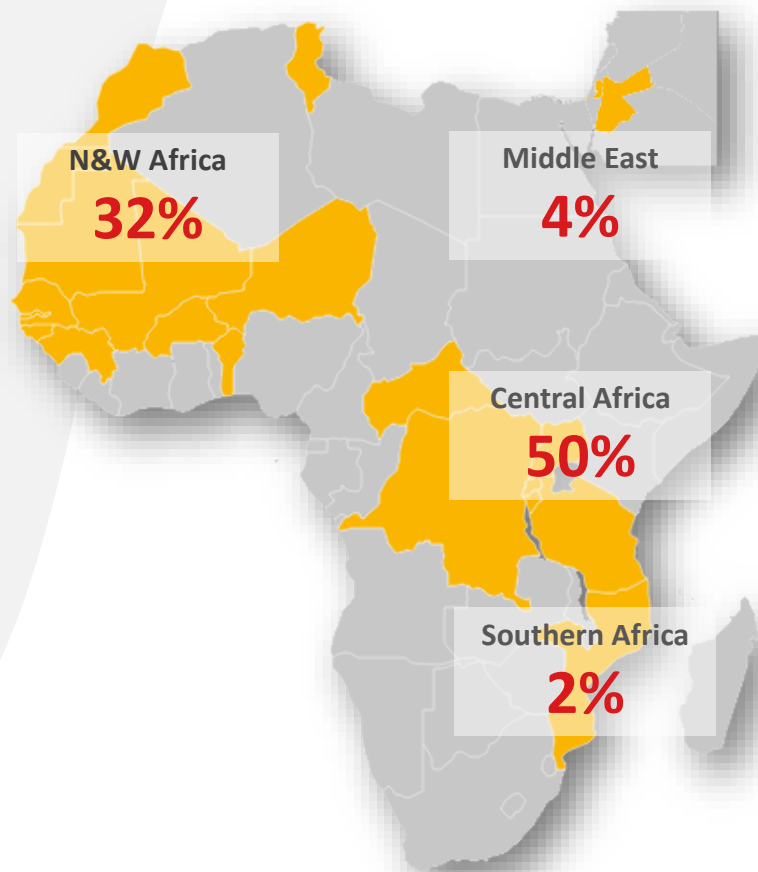

A major asset of Enabel is that the agency operates at several levels of power: **central, regional and operational** (execution).

## More impact

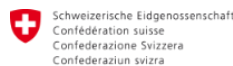
In order to enhance the impact of Belgian cooperation, Enabel also carries out actions in partnership with **Belgian, European and international organisations.**

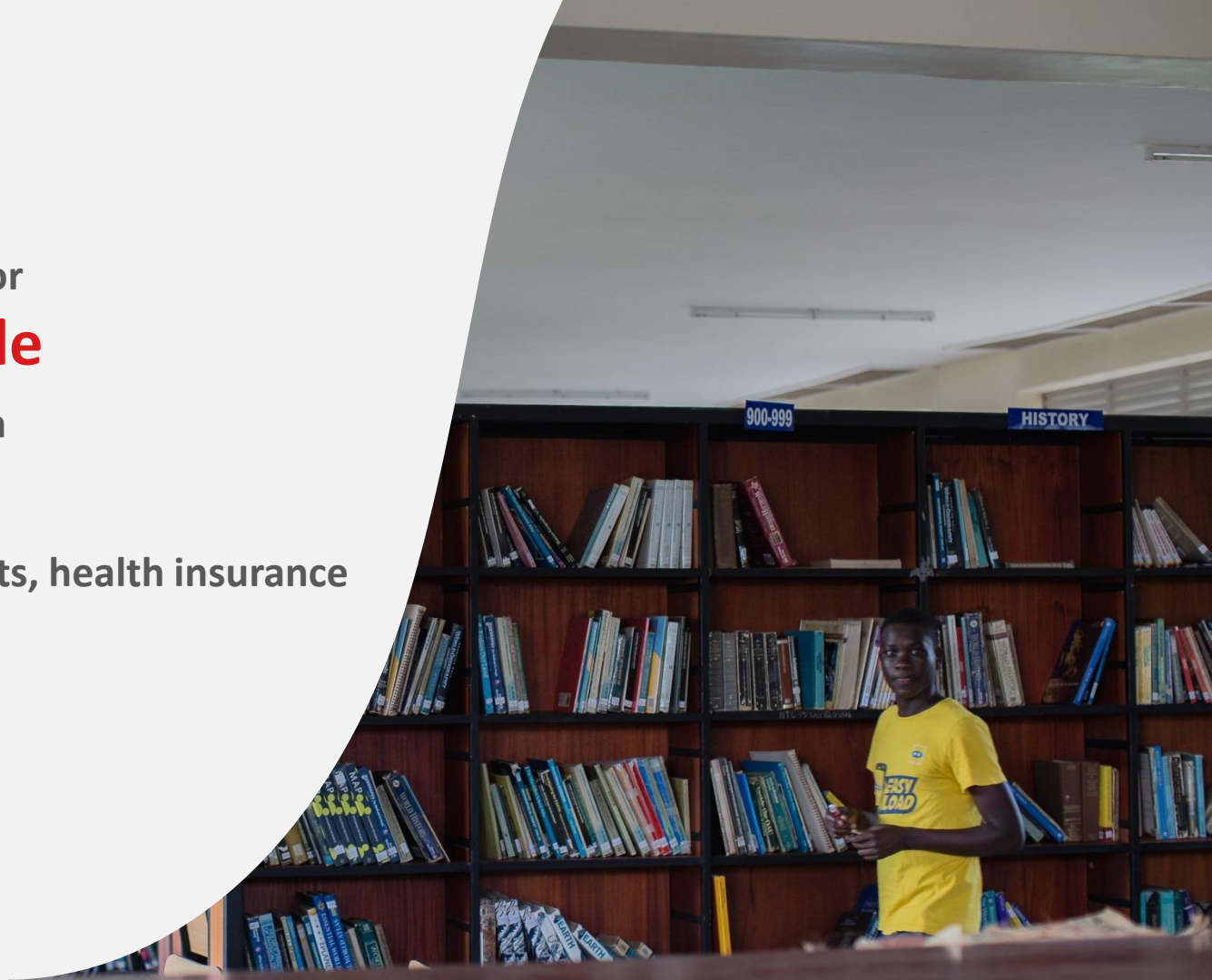

# Green buildings

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- Reference hospitals for **500,000 people**
- Schools for more than **12,000 pupils**
- Public buildings (courts, health insurance centres...)



# Water

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- Drinking water for **180,000** people
- River basin management for **10 million people**
- Agriculture - irrigation **of 2,000 ha**





# Energy

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Access to electricity for

**900,000 people**

- connection to the power grid
- hydroelectric power stations
- solar panels



# Urbanisation

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- Master plans for resilient cities  
**500,000 people**
- Waste collection and management for  
**4 million people**





# Smart agriculture

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- Reforestation and agroforestry  
**18,000 ha**
- Recovery of agricultural land  
**60,000 ha**
- for **130,000 farmers**



# Port development

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## Port of Cotonou (Benin)

- Docking of the first ship **longer than 300 m**
- Pascaline Adjofogue, **first female pilot** in Benin





# Democracy

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## Democracy and civil participation

- Assistance with the elections in the Central African republic
- **2 million voters** registered



# Security

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## Burkina Faso

- In a context of terrorist threat the **first National Security Forum** brings together more than 2,300 stakeholders with a view to reforming the security sector.



# Civil registry

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## Mali

- Modernisation and digitisation of the civil registry for better service delivery to citizens (**birth, marriage and death certificates**)





# Justice

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## Burundi

- Strengthening justice institutions and ministerial departments
- Archiving, better planning of court sessions, improved general functioning of the criminal departments = **lower prison occupancy rates**



# Education

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Strengthening technical and vocational education and training in Uganda, for Ugandans and for refugees in the north of the country.

**70% of graduates** found a job.





# Social protection

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Pilot project in Senegal

**300,000 people**

subscribe to health insurance schemes.

The model is rolled out to the national scale.



# DR Congo

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## 16,000 households

doubled maize yields thanks to the fight against erosion, the adoption of ecological and climate-smart measures (crop rotation and combination, natural fertilisers...).



# Palestine

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To be an entrepreneur in Palestine is a real challenge.

Six business incubators have professionalised through an EU project, allowing them to improve the services delivered to some

**142 start-ups.**

Only 3 of these start-ups did not complete the development path.





# Mozambique

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The first batteryless solar-powered water desalination plants in Africa provide access to drinking water to

**more than 7,000 people**  
in remote areas of Mozambique.

These plants are exploited by a local private business employing 15 staff.



# Human mobility

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The European PALIM pilot project links **Moroccan ICT sector** development and labour shortages in **Flanders** in collaboration with the Flemish employment service, employers federation and technology federation.

- **120 talents** trained in Morocco
- **200 companies** interested (in Morocco and Belgium)



# Niger

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**Child marriage is no longer a problem** in six schools in the Dosso region of Niger.

That success was achieved through a pilot project equipping schools with study spaces, latrines and manuals before an intensive campaign was launched to raise awareness among the parents, community leaders and the girls themselves.





# Global citizenship education

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## Embedding **global citizenship education** in the Belgian **education system**

- Kruit & Annoncer la Couleur
- 10,000 teachers trained
- 500 school teams accompanied
- 50 events aimed at stakeholders
- 90% satisfaction about the training offer
