Power Profile 2023 will focus on the People's Republic of China. There is not a country on the planet, nor any issue of international politics, in which China does not play a major role. Many fear a confrontation between China and the United States, or the West as a whole; perhaps some wish for that scenario; others seek to maintain cooperative relations on issues of shared interest. In every scenario, China's future "grand strategy" is of the utmost importance for the future of the world – that will be the topic of the first session of the conference. As that strategy is shaped in many ways by China's domestic concerns, these are what the second session will address.
